b) Management Report

- 1. Overpaid Sales Tax Refunds Update Working on the sales tax refunds. Board recommends management processes higher refund amounts first based on invoices of \$500 or more.
- 2. <u>Cambria Private Storm Water Pond Maintenance</u> —Work is completed to specifications of Pierce County. SMA is invoicing and processing for payment. Cambria homeowners will need a specific assessment.

3. Site Maintenance Update

- Arborist Tree Service, \$100 fee to look at it, if awarded they will waive the fee
 for the tree in the greenbelt. Board requested Glen of Knotty Tree Service to
 evaluate.
- Grass Damage entrance by the pond, we used ten hours of landscaping time and they put grass seed out on 06-12-13.
- Cambria fence is damaged and vandalized. Would like to re-use boards from other fence projects to replace broken ones in Cambria.
- Deer Ridge waiting for proposal for monument repairs.

- Dead trees on the boulevard. We have received two bids and will be getting a third bid to replace.
- Standing water on the tennis courts possibly a cracked main, approx. \$400 to repair. Campbell's has recommended a master valve at the water main.
- Nichols house in Cambria house was in probate, Home is now sold and a payment to assessments was provided in the amount of \$2,026.68. The remaining balance of \$586.00 will be written off.
- Oak Pointe Requested that PSE bill SMA for their lights. PSE said it is not easy and would break the current contract with Oak Pointe, 9 lights are SMA's and 3 are Oak Pointes. SMA's staff will continue discussions on options to separate lighting.

- a) <u>Cambria Property (Previously West)</u> Need to find out if the house is insured under SMA's policy. Vicki will be checking on this and report back.
- b) Common Area Management Emerald Pointe at Sunrise.
